## *Please Join Us!*

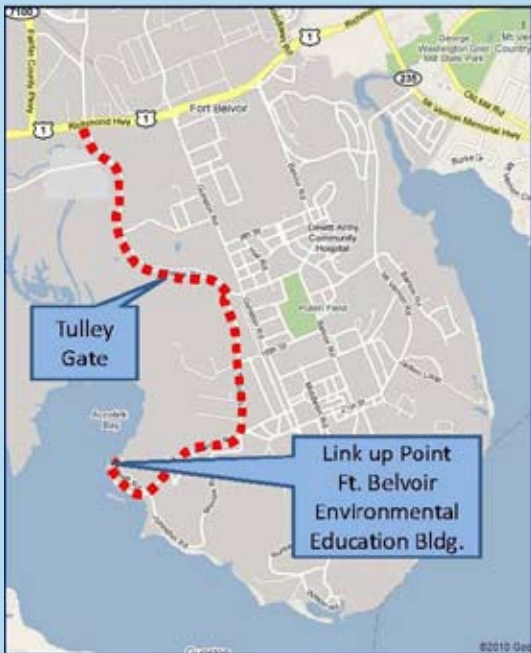
